pencil

eraser

paper scissors

fabric scissors

plastic spoon

old credit card to use as a squeegee

newsprint paper - Karen will provide

Cotton gauze 'screen' fabric - Karen will provide

old smooth low loft towel that you don't mind getting paint on

apron/old shirt that you don't mind getting paint on.

fabric to print on - this doesn't need to be pre washed

general purpose masking tape

cutting mat

The following are needed but are available to purchase from my [shop](#):

craft knife

6" embroidery hoop

water based acrylic fabric paint

extra cotton gauze fabric if wanted

STITCHING MATERIALS LIST

A variety of hand sewing needles to match thread weights:

- size 4 or 5 for couching
- Size 9/10/11 for hand piecing and appliqué. My personal preference for hand piecing Jeana Kimball size 9 Embroidery/Redwork and for appliqué Sue Daley size 11 milliners needles available from [my website](#).

50wt thread for hand piecing

80wt thread for needle turn appliqué and English Paper Piecing

A variety of threads for couch stitching. My go to is Aurifil 12wt wool but you can absolutely use any embroidery thread you already have. The more interesting the better!

A variety of fabrics in cottons, linens, plains, prints in sizes from scraps to FQs of ones you want to use more of. More info in the coming months.

Usual sewing supplies of scissors, rulers, cutting mat, rotary cutter, appliqué pins, travel iron and board if have.
